RACE TRACK INFORMATION



Heat Racing:

10:00am Driver's Briefing

10:30am - 1 x Look-Laps, followed by 2 x Track-Pack practice laps, ending with a chequered Flag and a return to the pits. All offroad racing classes on track together as a group. And the Kiwi-Trucks do the same, using there special track, separately.

11am - Racing Starts

Race grids are 2 wide.

All races are "Rolling Starts".

3 Heat Races per field x 5 laps duration, for all Groups.

For all Offroad Groups Heat One lines up with the first to enter event on pole. The grid is formed in order of entries received with the last or late entries on the back rows. Heats 2 & 3 grids will be determined by logarithm rotation.

Feature Racing:

The Offroad Feature Racing in groups. Starting positions determined by Heat Race finishing order with the fastest off the front.

Prizes:

Offroad Trophies decided by total accumulation of points from all races.

There will be 4 Feature Races.
